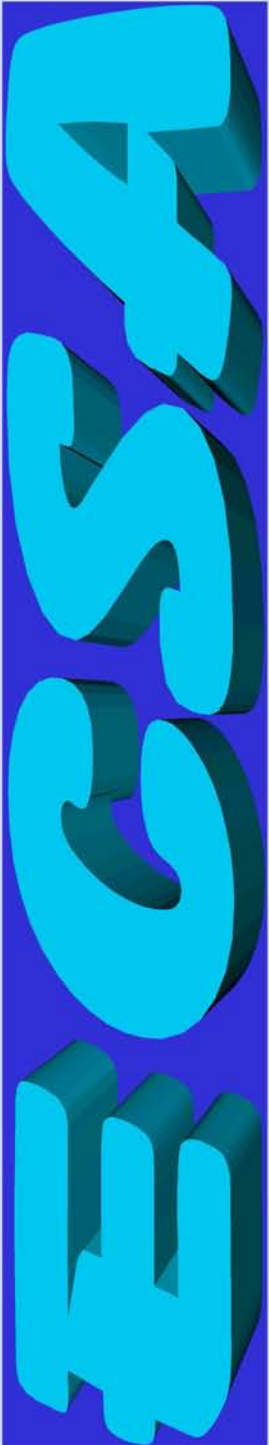

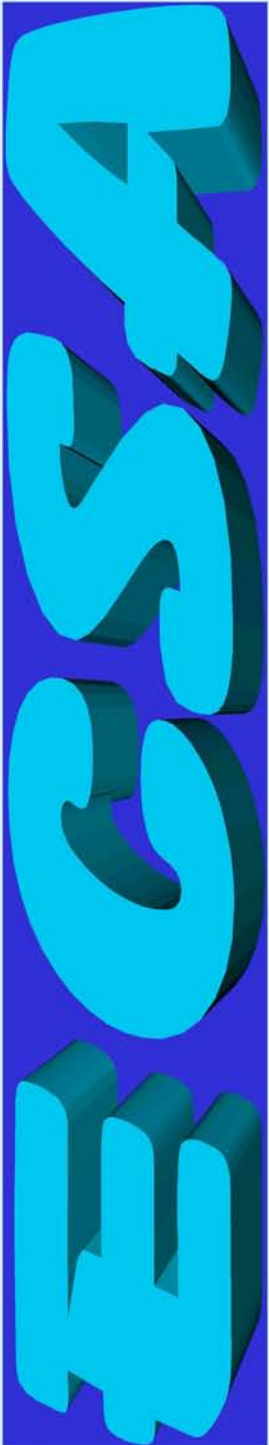
Category 2: Work Based Activities

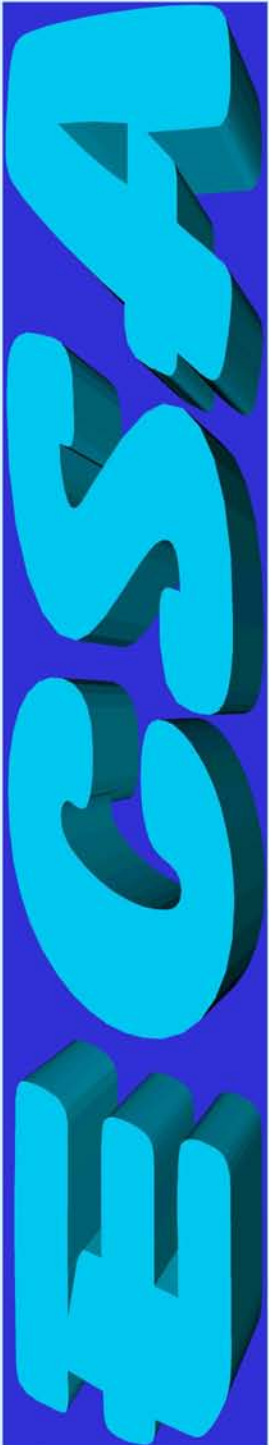
2.1 Engineering Work incl Management

* 400 hours = 1 credit - max 2

2.2 Professional mentoring of engineering candidates/practitioners

* 50 hrs = 1 credit - max 1





Category 3: Individual Activities

3.1 Membership of ECSA recognised VA

* 1 Credit max

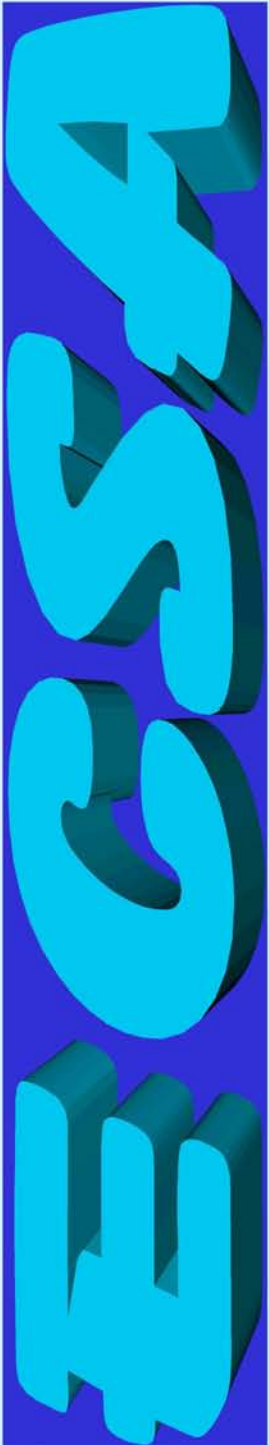
3.2 Other individual activities

- Part-time lecturing
- Supervision of post-graduate students
- External examining
- Publication of research work
- Publication of technical articles
- Presenting papers at conferences, etc
- Participation in statutory, professional, institutional, technical or non-technical committees
- Evaluation of educational programs/qualifications/reg application
- Obtaining relevant additional qualifications (up to 5 credits)
- Self-study: technical journals, electronic and printed material

* 10 hrs or per activity = 1 Credit, 3 max

5 YRLY APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL

1. APPLY 3 MNTHS PRIOR TO ANNIVERSARY
2. APPLICATION FORM (SINGLE PAGE)
3. CONFIRM 25 CREDITS OVER 5 YEARS
4. FEE

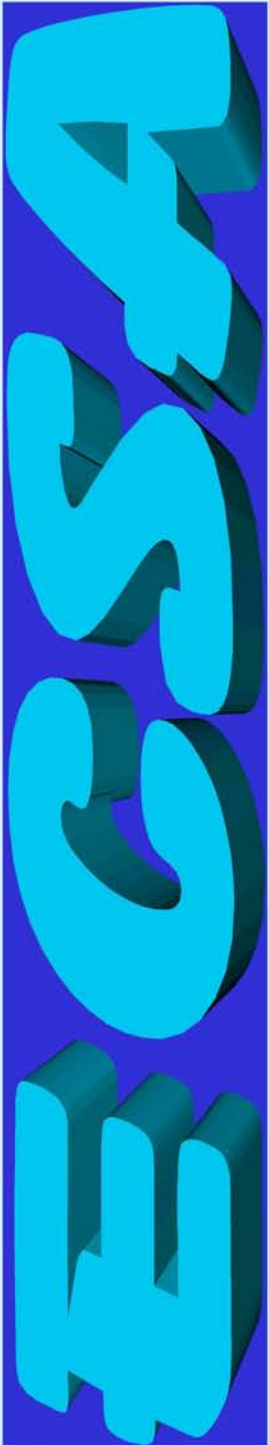


AUDITING OF CPD RECORDS

ECSA will conduct random audits of up to 10% of the CPD records of all registered persons in the different categories of registration annually

It is essential to retain full records of CPD for at least 5 years

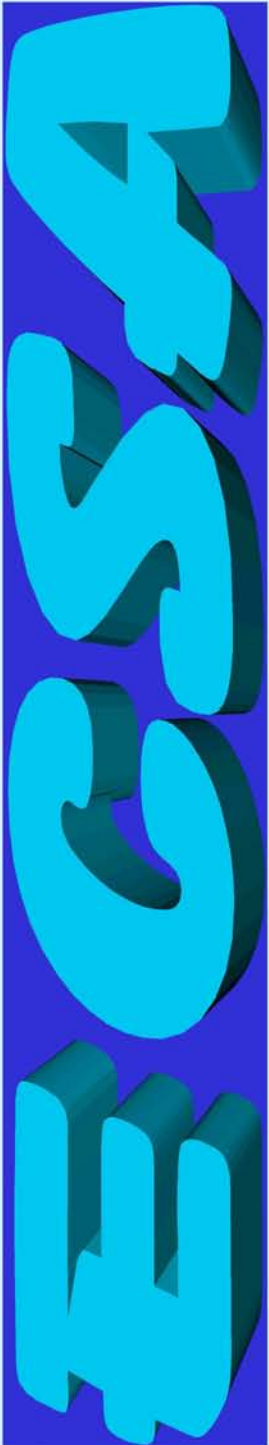
Unacceptable CPD records will be referred to the relevant Registration / Professional Advisory Committee



NON-COMPLIANCE

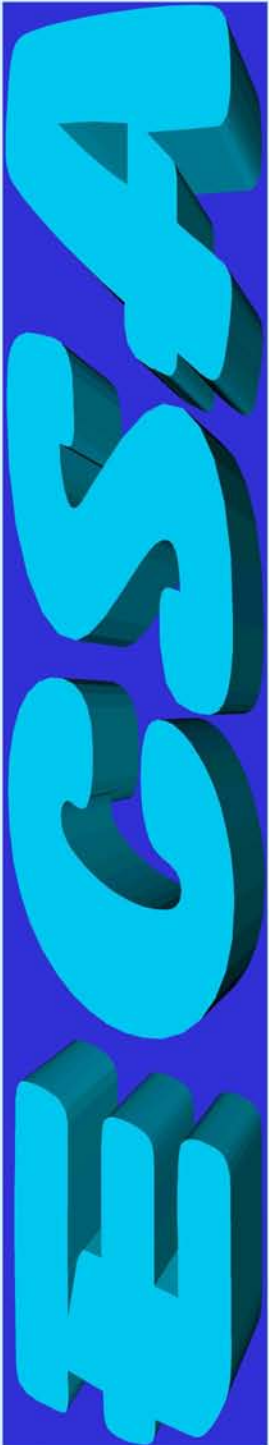
In the event of a registered person not complying with the requirements of the CPD system, ECSA may impose any one or more of the following conditions:

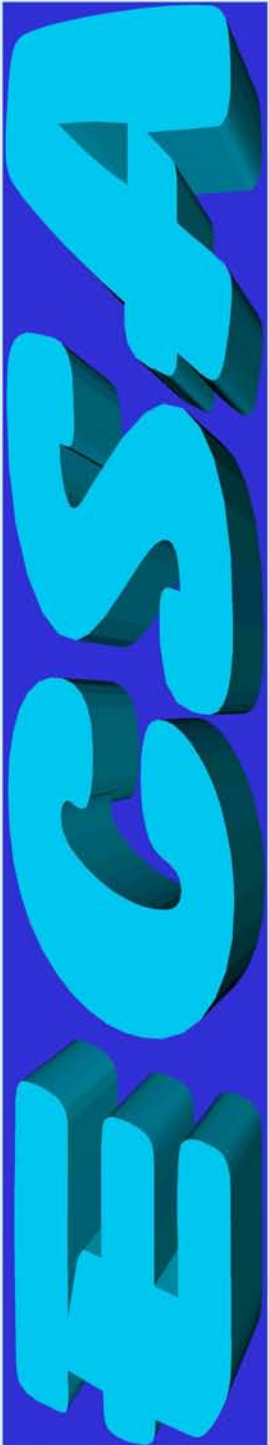
- Require the registered person to follow an approved remedial programme of continuing professional development within a period prescribed by ECSA.
- Removing the registered person's name from the relevant register.



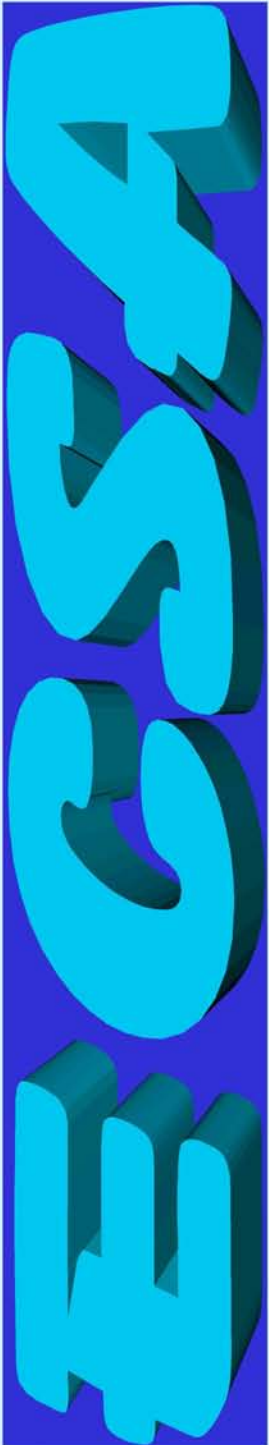
LATEST FROM CPD WORKING GROUP

- Separate application form for RoR;
- Random audit of up to 10% in respect of registered persons due for RoR each year
- SETA courses in NQF levels 5 to 8 acceptable as Cat 1 Developm activities
- Big employers like ESKOM, TELKOM and Bateman, with training centres, are NOT exempted from the requirement to have courses validated by the relevant voluntary associations
